Ruth Seid reported on the Collective Bargaining Education Project. New Rules of Conduct were discussed.

President Henry reported on the AFSCME Council 36 endorsement of John Chiang for Governor. **It was moved by Kian Daizadeh, second by Ruth Seid, and passed to donate \$2,500 to John Chiang's campaign for Governor, or, if the limit for contributions is less than \$2,500, then to contribute the limit.**

Ana Campos reported that Madeline Pena will be the new national president of REFORMA and Edwin Rodarte will be the president of the Los Angeles Chapter. She asked for a contribution to the Los Angeles chapter's scholarship fund.

It was moved by Ana Campos and seconded by Jim Sherod, and passed that the Guild donate \$1500 to the Los Angeles Chapter of REFORMA's Elizabeth Martinez Scholarship Fund.

Henry Gambill announced that the next membership meeting will be on Saturday, June 16, 2018 at the Palms Rancho Park Branch, which has plenty of parking.
